Background

Karauli district known as DANG and one of the most backward districts of the state require attention every aspect of development specially in health sector.

People of this district deprived from primary health care even though from last five years there is not a single ophthalmologist appointed in the entire district. It's an adverse situation to the population at large in this era.

Thus NIRA has also planned to organize a free eye care services through oragnizinf operation camp with the financial assistance from Jaipur world City Society, and DBS and FLWB/WILD GEESE Foundation the Netherlands.

Goal

The ultimate goal of the Free Eye Camp was to be transplant the lenses in eyes of the cataract patients so that their eye vision improved and d their work independently

Objectives

The main objectives of the camp were:

- Informed the community at large through various communications and media sources about the camp and availability of services in the camp
- Registered all participating patients in the camp
- ❖ Eye check ups and diagnosis of all registered patients in camp.
- To made aware to the all diagnosed patients about healthy care of their eves.
- ❖ To operate all identified the cataract patients for installation of lenses through operations.
- Follow up and guidance of operated patients for effective and successful operations.

Methodology

The following methodology was adopted to make the camp successful, result oriented and beneficial to the patients.

Permission and Sanction

The Institute received the written permission and sanction from Dr. C. I. Meena, Chief Medical & Health Officer, Karauli to organize the free eye camp at Kela Devi, Karauli form February 22 to 24, 2007. The copy of the approval in enclosed at Annexure-I

IEC Activities

To communicate the massage of organization of the camp to community at large the following activities were planned:

- Distribution of handbills
- Display of Posters
- Display of Banners
- News in Local News Paper
- Slides on local TV Cable
- Announcement by mike / audio cassette
- Personal Contacts
- Household contacts

Disinfected the operation room and wards

It was jointly decided with doctor's team that operation room and all wards would be disinfected so that infection could not be transmitted t the patients.

Registration of the all patients

It was decided that all patients would be registered so that maximum benefit can be given to the patients for identification of eye operations and general check up.

Operation of the patients

All identified patients would be operated within the time period of the camp so that ultimate goal of the camp could be achieved.

Photography of operated patients

Group Photographs would be taken so that an authentic record of the patients could be maintained and submitted to the funding agency.

Follow up Activities

Activities Organized

The following activities were organised for making the camp successful and result orientated.

Distribution of handbills

To disseminate the massage about the camp three thousand handbills were distributed in the surrounding villages in the 15 Kms of the radius. The copy of the handbill in at Annexure-IV

Display of the Posters

To communicate the date and place of the camp the posters have been displayed at the major public gathering points if the covered villages. A sample copy of poster is at Annexure-V

Display of the Banners

To communicate the massage to community at large twenty banners have been displayed at the major transportation points, Important public gathering points with a massage of date, venue, doctors team, facilities and attendants instructions along with the supporting and organizing agencies.

News in local Newspaper

Although; the majority of population effected by this problem illiterate and aged but news paper has authentic source of the information. Local newspaper is common and most famous in the area. Before the camp a massage to inform the people has been published and after the camp the total number and the general information with the precaution has been disseminated to the local population.

Slides on local TV cable

Before 20 days of the date of camp the informative slides were visualized on television through the local TV cable. By this type of information urban population could be informed.

Announcement through mike and audio cassette

To convey the massage of free eye camp in remote area, a jeep with facility of mike, loud speaker and dubbed cassette was played.

Disinfected the operation room and wards

The operation room and all wards were disinfected on 21st Feb, 2007.

Inauguration of the camp

The free eye camp was inaugurated by hon'ble Krishna Chandra Pal, Ex. Empire, Karauli Estate by lighting in front of the poster of Goddess Kela Devi.He pointed out the gaps in health care services not only at the primary but also secondary and tertiary levels. Since freedom; we are struggling even to primary health care in the area in particular.

But due to geographical terrines the task are toughest. I have asked to institutional representative that "Few months ago a eye camp has been organised at the same place and now why do you interested to organize at the same place?" Now, the gathering is itself an answer. And there is also a question "How much the cataract patients to be treated or operated in the district?" District Blindness Committee organizing the eye operation camp since last few years and are the good efforts.

Only eye is not the health problem in the area but also there is need to organize separate camps for other diseases. Kela Devi Trust Hospital will be functionalizing very shortly. The accessibility for the services to lehman through hospital will be at the priority.

He humbly thanked to the guests and people on participating in the inauguration session and welcome to the services; first of all at registration table.


Registration

Two NIRA officials have registered the all male and female patients approached to

the camp.188 Male and 119 Female, total 307patients were registered in the camp.

Diagnosis

All the registered patients diagnosed and 124 identified to the cataract operation in the out door of the patients and admitted for the operation. It has been accomplished till the evening so that those patients who were not identified to the operation could reach to home back




in time. The medicines were also distributed to the eye patients

Profile of the Operated Patients

Sex:

Out of 124 identified only 120 had undergone the cataract eye operation. Out of these 120 59 were and 61 were female.




Age Distribution of the Operated Patients Above 50 Years 30 to 49 Years Below 30 Years 0 20 40 60 80 100 120


Age Distribution:

The analysis of data refers that the majority of the operated patients belongs to old age group. 114 were from the age group of above 50 years and 03 from 30 to 40 yrs. Age group, rest 03 were from below 30 years age group.

Education Level:

On the basis of two parameters the data short reflects that only 19 operated patients were literate, rest 101 were illiterate.





Caste Composition of the operated patients:

The analysis refers to caste based equity in the operated patients according to the demographic indicators, as 35, 27, 23 & 15 percent as OBC, ST, General and SC accordingly.

Health Check ups

Screened patients have been undergone the different tests before the operation. The blood pressure, blood, complete urine, Hb., history of the patients have been the main tests for the patients.

Operation of the patients

After admission of the patients and concerning test reports three times disinfection process followed by removing hairs from eye led and eye brow.

Import the block and preparation for the operation in the operation room.



Out of 124 patients admitted 120have been operated. 4 patients with plan cataract and 116 patients operated with IOL lenses in to three batches.

Post Operative Care:

During the whole night the patients had observed by NIRA officials and eye team members. They were advised to do not use the pillow and curve. Simple pain reliefs were also provided to the patients during night. In next day morning the bandages of the operated eye had changed with the new cotton and eye drop and timely followed.
